

Review of: "Clinical Implications of EMT in HNSCC: A Review of the Factors and Pathways at Play"

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This is a review summarizing the signal pathway analysis of EMT in HNSCC and its clinical significance. A notable aspect is the use of the PRISMA database tool for the collection of evidence-based papers.

Unfortunately, I am not familiar with how to use PRISMA, making it difficult to evaluate that part. However, the quality of the finally selected papers was ensured by the Newcastle-Ottawa tool, which is commendable. Nonetheless, it remains unclear whether there were other papers beyond the 16 selected that were not worthy of inclusion.

The content of each introduced paper mainly pertains to experiments on HNSCC cell lines regarding the EMT regulatory signal pathways. The content is compactly presented, making it easy to understand. I would have liked a deeper consideration from a clinical perspective.
