I consider that the work is interesting, since it analyses the emergence of new construction typologies in Calcutta, which do not maintain a natural security system. The analysis at different scales, neighbourhood, and district, is considered very accurate, covering urban and suburban development, and can be extrapolated to other sectors of the big city.

The results require further analysis, and the authors are encouraged to make further proposals for improvement and feasibility that serve local, regional and state administrations.
