paper provides a clear introduction to the concept of Eproccos and its objective of bringing digital transformation to the customized components industry. However, there are some points in the text that could be addressed:

1. In the abstract, it would be helpful to provide a clearer definition and explanation of what Eproccos is and how it operates, as this would make it easier for readers to understand the concept.
2. Although the text mentions that a financial analysis has been conducted indicating that Eproccos is profitable and has a return on investment expected within three years, there is no supporting data or details provided to validate this claim. To strengthen the argument for investing in Eproccos, including more information on the financial projections would be beneficial.
3. The text acknowledges that the lead-time for product delivery is not consistent or fixed, but it fails to explain why this is the case or how Eproccos plans to address this issue. To enhance the credibility of the business plan, providing additional information on proposed solutions would be valuable.
4. The text employs technical terms and concepts such as Industry 4.0, assuming that readers are familiar with them, without providing sufficient context or explanation. Making the text more accessible to a wider audience could be achieved by including more background information or definitions.
