- 1. The article it's a bit hard to read and confusing. There isn't a match between the title, the abstract ("This work introduces a standardized approach for assessing thermal comfort in real-world settings. The study examines the continuous use of hybrid ventilation systems at Kadhimiya Teaching Hospital to ensure a consistent air quality in the wards.") and the objectives listed in Chapter 1 ("to (1) conduct a comprehensive evaluation and critical examination of the current body of research on CGCC, (2) consolidate the outcomes into a cohesive, multidimensional, and interdisciplinary knowledge framework, and (3) identify potential areas of research that have not been adequately explored, with the aim of suggesting future directions for investigation"). Please revise and improve the abstract and the introduction.
- 2. Figure 4 is not clear. Please improve it.
- 3. The conclusions should be improved to highlight the results of the study according to the aim of the work.
