- 3. Make your own tables in the article.
- 4. The title of the paper is unclear. You most change it appropriately or clarify its meaning.
- 5. Clearer dividing line between contributions from other authors and your contribution What is your contribution to science with this article?
- 6. The article needs to be more focused. Core themes digitisation and Spanish tourism needs to be more exposed and researched. There should be more references from this two research fields.
- 7. In Chapter 4 I would expect from the author to explain his findings from his own research. In this Chapter there are too many other references.
- 8. There is also too much referencing of old literature. I suggest that the author uses only the core old literature in the article.
- 9. I'd also agree with dr. Florida Benitez that we don't know exactly what the article is: a literature review, a case study,....
