Overall, the manuscript contains a very rich and thought-provoking description of the healthcare system and its problems. Below are some suggestions.

- In recent years, the Bangladesh government has prioritised healthcare as a key development area, aiming to improve healthcare infrastructure, expand services, and strengthen the overall healthcare system: from-which-period?
- Despite facing many challenges, Bangladesh has made remarkable progress in achieving health and population indicators, particularly in achieving health-related Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), such as MDG 4 and MDG 5, concerned with improving infant survival and maternal health, respectively: what was this advance? What were the results of the indicators before per year, and how are they now? In what period?. - I suggest adding a description of the type of government, general population, territory, a brief history of the health system, and its main characteristics according to indicators such as: doctors per 1000 inhabitants; nurses per 1000 inhabitants; beds per 1000 inhabitants; Primary Care coverage; child mortality; maternal mortality; main causes of mortality
- Regarding financing, I suggest including data on the percentages of public and private spending over time.
- It could better describe the attention to the rural population. What are these rural hospitals like? What type of services do they offer?
