Even though the title and abstract attract me, the introduction doesn't have any citations. What is the source of those ideas? The content could be well developed if authors from different schools, with different opinions, had presented. The section would be stronger and more interesting. The section about Curriculum was supported by literature and has interesting concepts, such as Flipped Classroom. The authors didn't cite the source for Figure 1, and the next discussion, competencies. This could be a serious concern, since authors, editors, and publishers are very sensitive (and they're completely right) to plagiarism. To avoid problems, the authors should review the text, find the sources of this content, and cite them.
