Review of: "Dirac's Large Number Hypothesis: An Ongoing Quest for Correlations Between the Infinitesimal and the Infinite"

It is well written and informative. It is not a research paper, but it is a useful review.

I consider that there is a reiteration when they quote the ratio between the Electrostatic Force and the Gravitational Force between a Proton and an Electron, and then separately the Intensity of Electromagnetic - Gravitational Interaction between Elementary Particles. In addition, in the last case, I interpret that the formula the authors are quoting is the ratio α/G , where α is the fine structure constant? If so, this is not quite correct since α is dimensionless but G is not, and hence this ratio cannot be a pure number. Apart from this nicety, the exposition is fairly complete and competent.
