- 1. The abstract portion is worded quite effectively.
- 2. The introduction is very short; it must elaborate on all concepts and variables mentioned in the title. The authors must also develop a theoretical background in which the study may be rooted with proper rationale.
- 3. The methodology section is well written, but here some justifications with proper references are needed for the use of inferential statistics in the current study.
- 4. The data analysis is excellent and adequately explained; however, during the discussion section, both studies were presented for and against the findings, but a balanced viewpoint is missing to justify the current findings.
- 5. To sum up, the study examined a crucial subject and made excellent efforts; following minor revisions, it may be considered for publishing.

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
