

## Review of: "Developments in Regional Inequality in Greece"

The article studies the recent evolution of inequality in Greece with reference to the years 2017-2022. Standard methods are used to distinguish between intra-regional and interregional inequality. The main conclusion is that overall inequality was lower in 2022 than in 2017, although inequality across regions increased. The topic is interesting, and the writing is clear. However, the approach is exclusively descriptive, and most of the issues raised remain unexplored. In particular, it is unclear what the impact of the pandemic is, why within- and between inequality have the observed dynamics, and why the contributions to total inequality of regions change over time. Also, a comparison with the evolution observed in a different period or in another country would be helpful. Finally, more detail should be given on the computation of data reported in the table. Best wishes for the improvement of the paper!
