It is suggested to the author to reformulate the text by choosing which themes to deal with, what is the hypothesis, what is the objective how to reach it. As it stands, the text seems to be composed of several parts that are not coherent with each other.

The length of the text is also excessive for a scientific article.

Since the initial premises are not clear, hypothesis and objective, it means that the methodological part has serious gaps which are then evident when the conclusions are drawn.
