What was the number of HCP eligible for the study versus the number who actually responded to the survey. A sample of 103 participants seems rather small for such a large institution with a variety of surgical sub-specialties. The limitations of the study were pointed out by the authors, the small sample size and single center makes it difficult to generalize the findings. This study would be of interest only to the Malaysian health care system.
