I would like to emphasize that the idea of comparing the management of a construction project with business management is very interesting.

I would like to see more specifics, for example:

- 1) More project management methods (Lean, PMBOK, PRINCE2, Six Sigma, and others)
- 2) A comparative table that identifies criteria for comparison and compares the construction project management method with other project management methods
- 3) More sources that review a similar problem, in order to gain a clearer understanding of other opinions on this topic
- 4) Suggestions on how the management of the construction process could be changed, for example, the implementation of BIM technologies from a management perspective or the MBSE approach

Overall, the work is interesting but requires further refinement for greater scientific rigor.
