The research topic is very interesting, focusing on the recycling and storage behavior of mobile phones from the perspectives of age and gender. The writing is relatively smooth and the structure of the paper is clear, but there are the following issues. It is recommended that the author carefully revise them.

- 1. The structure of the paper needs to be adjusted. After proposing the research model, the paper did not elaborate on the research hypotheses or provide necessary explanations and explanations for the variables in the model. Suggest adding research hypotheses section.
- 2. In the research review section, firstly, there is a lack of theoretical basis explanation, and secondly, there is a lack of summary discussion of previous relevant research. Suggest adding a theoretical foundation section and a literature overview on mobile phone recycling and preservation behavior.
- 3. Data analysis and methods. The data analysis only includes statistical descriptive analysis, lacks explanatory statistical analysis, and lacks validation of research hypotheses. The charts in the text are too cumbersome, and it is recommended to simplify them. Suggest adding regression analysis between variables and supplementing the validation of research hypotheses.
- 4. In the discussion section, this article combines the data analysis and discussion sections together. It is recommended to separate the two parts and delve into the data connections between the analysis variables.
- 5. In terms of format, there is an issue with the serial number encoding, and it is recommended to modify it.

To conclude I think the idea is good but it should be better developed.
