

# Review of: "[Review] Sarcopenia in Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19): All to Know from Basic to Nutritional Interventions from Hospital to Home"

Unfortunately the quality of the English language in this paper detracts from the quality of the article content and makes it difficult to review. While making the connection between sarcopenia and COVID 19 infection, and touching on systemic inflammatory response, level of physical activity and nutrition, the mechanisms of action are briefly listed but not elaborated upon, nor are there references to support possible common pathogeneses. Additionally, interventions for sarcopenia are not detailed nor differentiated from critical illness acquired weakness (ie CIM, CIN). I would be particularly interested in interventions upon home discharge for these patients, beyond protein intake and ongoing monitoring.
