Following points to be addressed if feasible

A) What DUS parameters did they use for the assessment of varicocele (vein diameter, reflux duration, and length, or other parameters)?

B) Did the authors use alpha Cronbach reliability analysis?

C) The idea of replacing palpation with DUS is not novel (e.g., Hirsch et al., 1980).

D) In most cases, palpation is sufficient (and cost-effective) for the detection of varicocele.
