The article has given a good review of the multilevel health model based on health measurement instruments. The article is relatively easy to read; however, with some missing information, it's difficult to understand some parts. Correcting them could have made the article better.

1. The author can add a problem statement in the abstract to give a clear overview of the purpose of the study. The reason for the missing three dimensions can be added in the result paragraph.
2. In the text, the citation is based on Kaiser et al. (2021); however, in the list of references, it is stated as Kaiser et al. (2023).
3. Appendix 1 cannot be found in the article or the additional file.
4. In the synthesis of the results section, the author should explicitly explain the integration process and the assessment of the instruments for better understanding.
5. The author mentioned that an independent reviewer performed the study selection process. Is the reviewer the author himself or another expert? Is this the same reviewer for instrument assessments?
