As a reviewer, I have carefully assessed the content of the manuscript and have identified several areas that need improvement before it can be considered suitable for publication.

Firstly, one glaring omission is the absence of a methodology section. A robust methodology is crucial for ensuring the validity and reproducibility of research findings. Without a clear articulation of the methods employed, it is challenging for readers to assess the rigor of the study and replicate the results. Therefore, I strongly recommend that the author include a comprehensive methodology section detailing the research design, data collection procedures, and analytical techniques employed in the study.

Moreover, the paper fails to adequately explain how the outcomes were derived. It is essential for the author to elucidate the analytical approach used to interpret the data and generate the results presented in the manuscript. Providing a clear explanation of the analytical methods will enhance the credibility of the findings and facilitate a better understanding of the research process.

While the manuscript addresses an important topic, it falls short of the standards expected for publication in an academic journal. I urge the author to revise the paper to address the aforementioned concerns, particularly by incorporating a methodology section and clarifying the analytical approach. By doing so, the manuscript will significantly enhance its scholarly impact and contribute meaningfully to the existing literature.
