The theme of the article, life skills, especially in the field of social work and through different pedagogical proposals to create an active, conscious and committed learning community with the knowledge and skills to solve the demands of the environment, putting the voice of underrepresented students at the centre, seems relevant to me.

I consider that the article would need, in any case, to improve its structure, to specify sections that separate and at the same time give continuity to the phases, that is to say, the state of the question has to derive in the object of study, this in the method, the method in the result, and the result in the conclusions. Sometimes they are mixed up with each other, and this makes them difficult to read and understand.

Nevertheless, I believe that the project, as I pointed out earlier, addresses relevant issues that it resolves and discusses.

The conclusions obtained are important for social work, which is why I encourage the authors to organise all these necessary findings in the sections mentioned above, separating and linking the theoretical aspects that support the hypothesis with the objectives, and these with the method used to achieve them, so that the results and conclusions are clearly associated with the objectives.
