This is a very effective paper and I have few to no comments to make for what concerns its theoretical features. My only recommendation is more related to the style and composition of the paper. The text, because of its theoretical density would benefit from a more linear and section based composition in order to facilitate the engagement of several aspects of Leibniz's philosophy. I may be more sympathetic towards other readings of his philosophy (more Deleuzian or enactive/embodied) but the article is persuasive and extremely solid.
