My comments on the manuscript entitled "The $\alpha 7$ Nicotinic Acetylcholine Receptor: a Key Molecule in Post-COVID Syndrome?" are as follows.

1. The idea of the manuscript is very good; the abstract section should also include limitations of the manuscript (questions left unanswered) along with future prospects.
2. Introduction section is unnecessarily very long; focus on your major objectives and approaches utilized in the study of your manuscript. Novelty should be included in this section with appropriate justification.
3. Include a discussion section of about 500 words just before the conclusion section.
4. Include limitations and future prospects in the conclusion section of your manuscript.
5. Review manuscript is not merely a collection and citations of literature's, your own assessment at the end of each paragraph will be required at the end of each paragraph.
07. Overall writing and presentation is sloppy with major grammatical errors, and substantial revision is needed to improve the manuscript and further clarification is required in some areas.
08. Include a couple of relevant bibliographic studies like PMID: 36092161 and PMID: 33091590 in your manuscript.
09. Complete editorial checking will be needed for the whole manuscript.
10. Submit a proof of English editing certificate with the revised manuscript.
