Review of: "Sociodemographic, Clinical, and Psychological Barriers to Medication Compliance: The Case of Patients with Musculoskeletal Disorders in Greece"

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Thank you for submitting your work to the magazine, thus contributing to greater and better adherence to therapy by patients.

The background should be more developed and in-depth. The introduction should be more well-founded and concise.

It does not present descriptors.

Regarding methods, the sample size is small; it is also not clear how the data was obtained and which individuals it excluded or included.

When discussing the results, you should not repeat the objective. It is not very developed, lacks robustness, and comparison with results from other authors.

Another important weakness of the work is the significant limitations of its study.

You need to write a Conclusion, in which you should mention possible areas for future research, or other suggestions, as well as emphasize the study's findings for patients, health professionals, and policy managers.

In terms of bibliographical references, they used relevant sources, although some of them were old and dated back to the 80s. During the discussion, many authors were not mentioned to compare results.
