Review of: "When Algorithms Decide: The Controversial Role of AI in Cancer Care Auditing"

This paper makes a timely effort to address the use of AI in cancer care auditing. The cases reported in this paper are only tested with the ChatGPT model; it would be better to use other models, including Gemini and DeepSeek, to further clarify the strengths and limits of these models. DeepSeek provides strong responses to prompts on medical information. ChatGPT can benefit the public by increasing awareness of cancer symptoms, its diagnosis, and medication. I suggest using benchmark datasets on cancers and employing multiple AI tools for the prediction of cancer. Relying only on ChatGPT could be further tested when similar information is passed to Gemini and DeepSeek.
