It is suggested to use dark traits instead of the dirty dozen in keywords.

Most of the participants in this study are women, and the variance of scores in each of the variables, especially in the personality traits, can be affected by gender, so the results of this study, without considering the role of gender, need more consideration. Please enter gender as a covariate into the regression equation and then report the results.

Did the authors look for a purposive sample that used the snowball sampling method?

Please report psychometric properties for all measures (The Light Triad traits, The Dark Triad Dirty Dozen, and the Sociosexual Orientation Inventory-Revised).

Please report valid references for The Dark Triad Dirty Dozen and the Sociosexual Orientation Inventory-Revised scales.

Result

For the normality test, it is necessary to use the Kolmogorov-Smirnov test and the Z-statistic, and it is not enough to mention the descriptive indices of skewness and elongation or the rules of thumb for the normality test.
