Interesting topic, good review. The article is a bit scholastic, very didactic. The cases are instructive. Perhaps a graph would be better to highlight the parameters and improvement trends. The article needs to be enriched a little; there are many interesting ideas in the literature, for example, on inappropriate tachycardia in sepsis or also on landiolol (<https://doi.org/10.1093/eurheartjsupp/suac121.143>) and levosimendan. The use of ultrasound, probably due to methodological problems, has never been shown to change outcomes in trials. Also mentioned are impedance metric techniques to calculate hydration in a non-invasive way.
