- 3. It should be mentioned what the rationale of the design is.
- 4. Reference for the synthesis method should be added.
- 5. Mechanism for the synthesis of compounds should be added as figures.
- 6. Discussion is some explanation about results; on the other hand, you repeat your results in this section. It should be extensively changed; you have to rewrite and use other published results to compare with yours.
- 7. The abstract is not complete. It should be rewritten again. The abstract should be completed in the background, aim, and conclusion sections.
- 8. Similar studies in this area should be added in the introduction part.

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
