6. Discussion is some explanation about results; on the other hand, you repeat your results in this section. It should be extensively changed; you have to rewrite and use other published results to compare with yours.
7. The abstract is not complete. It should be rewritten again. The abstract should be completed in the background, aim, and conclusion sections.
8. Similar studies in this area should be added in the introduction part.
