Review of: "The Evolving Landscape of Neuroscience"

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The article entitled "The evolving landscape of neuroscience" presents a broad overview of the field of research. In a huge work of classification of works published in quartiles 1 and 2 of Scopus, a systematic categorisation of the different research clusters identified, as well as their interrelationships, is carried out. The paper provides interesting findings both for scientific research in the area and for scientific communication. It highlights the identification of emerging trends, key issues, and research gaps in the scientific area, which in turn can serve as a guide for future research. Finally, the author provides the dataset and code used in open access, thus contributing to the dissemination of knowledge in a field as relevant and current as neuroscience.
