-Discuss potential confounding factors or alternative explanations for the conflicting evidence or interpretations of the association between zonulin levels and specific diseases.

-Improve clarity using concise language and better organization, including subheading key sections.

-Provide more accurate interpretations of the data presented, acknowledging potential limitations or alternative explanations. Discuss the implications of the findings in the context of the existing literature and highlight areas that require further investigation.

-Integrate evidence more coherently to support the arguments presented in the manuscript. Provide a clearer narrative that combines different lines of evidence and strengthens the overall argument. Provide a more comprehensive signaling pathway.
