'One type of this solid waste, which is a global concern, is plastic waste. To curb the pollution imposed by these plastics, most countries are recycling them to form usable construction materials such as pavement materials.'

should be removed and put in the introduction section.

2. This part of the abstract (Conclusion) should be recast:

From the results obtained, it can be concluded that, using only 25% polyethylene terephthalate for the production of a plastic pavement, the pavements could be used in monument premises and water-locked areas. Using 30% PP, the pavement could be used in streets and yards, while using 20% PP plus 10% PET, the pavement would be used in less-traffic areas.

It does not state the best % that can be used for the plastic pavement. 1.

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
