The case report by Gaudek and coworkers is potentially interesting and useful for the treatment of Long Covid, however, I have some criticisms.

Authors must clearly describe the drug and the administration schedule for each patient.

The clinical data regarding the patients should be reported instead of their statements and opinions about the treatment; moreover, laboratory data during and after the treatment could be useful to better understand the effects of the drugs administered.

In the discussion, authors hypothesize a role in Long Covid for exhausted CD8 cells. What about a possible therapeutic effect with immune checkpoint inhibitors?

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
