- 1. The work can be a significant contribution to the field of study.
- 2. In general, the manuscript is well organized and understandably described.
- 3. The work is well supported and not misleading.
- 4. The abstract needs to be rewritten, highlighting the importance of the marketing efficiency of channel IV Farmer-Consumer, as noted in the Conclusions.
- 5. In the Introduction, the authors present overall and specific objectives.
- 6. In the Review of Literature section, the authors should explain in more detail what beparies are and their importance in Bangladesh.
- 7. The Results and Discussion section needs to emphasize the main contributions of the paper. In this section, the authors must point out the parity of the BDT in relation to the US dollar.
- 7. The presentation of results could be improved if some graphs instead of tables is included in the manuscript.
- 9. In the Conclusion section, I suggest adding the shortcomings and prospects of the research. In this section, the authors should also explain the meaning of the word Mahajan.
- 10. Although in general the references are appropriate and adequate in relation to the field of study, they are outdated. I suggest that the authors make an effort to include more recent references.
