The manuscript is interesting. As mentioned in this manuscript, many reviewers neglect some quality controls for survival analysis during the review process. However, the manuscript has some issues that should be addressed.

- 1. The number of examples designed in this study is too small.
- 2. PCI is mainly used in patients with small cell lung cancer, and it is recommended to change the study selected for example.
- 3. Where the abbreviation appears for the first time, it is recommended to give a detailed name, such as the FDA.
- 4. The authors did not have a selection criteria for selecting these articles.
- 5. In my opinion, the survival curve of these articles is still missing a survival table.

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
