Review of: "Phosphatidylserine (PS)-Targeting Chimeric Interferon (IFN) Fusion Proteins for Anti-Tumour Applications"

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A very well-written and detailed paper. The authors' research approach seems well thought out and innovative, with significant research background.

I would like to give a few constructive feedback points on this paper:

The abstract section did not include a future work or directive that the authors aim to propose downstream of this research output.

I appreciate the breakdown of information that directed the authors on the choice of IFN-I and IFN-III for the fusion protein experiment. I was just wondering, could there be any synergistic effect coupling the fusion protein to IFN-II, even though IFN-II is divergent from the other two.
