The paper is well organized, but the writing quality drastically oscillates from one section to another. There are sections where the text flows quite smoothly, whereas there are counterparts with non-linear concatenation of ideas as well as repetitions (or even pleonasms). References throughout the text do not follow 'classic' standards, and the reference list (at the end) is definitely non-uniform. Coordinate axes (in graphs shown) contain serious flaws.
