- 1. Introduction: It is very long and unwanted elaboration. Actual importance of the topic should be highlighted, instead of describing importance of livestock sector.
- 2. Review of literature: Whether is it as per journal's format or not? It should be looked into very carefully.
- 3. Methodology applied should be supported by the standard references
- 4. Results and discussion: Very elaborative. Data presented in table elaborated in the form of text. It should be avoided. Excessive elaboration in all the sections of the manuscript has made the article very exhaustive for readers. Major things/findings should be highlighted in the text and discussed with relevant literature.
- 5. The presentation of the article looks like a project report / thesis. It needs improvement.
- 6. The conclusions are repetition of results and looking like a summary. Conclusion portion has to be rewritten as per the findings.
- 7. The article is suitable for publication only after major revision.
