- The choice of schools in the study area should be explained.
- The performed data analysis is very weak; only basic descriptive statistics were used. Statistical analysis and results can be strengthened using inferential statistics.
- In the Discussion, reflect on the achievement of the goal and hypothesis, highlight the advantages and limitations of the research, compare the results with other studies, highlight the contribution of the work, make suggestions for future work, etc.
