The findings are reasonable. Despite some positive impression, I would like to bring up a few issues as follows. The clarity of the research's problem needs to be strengthened. It is not clear the significance of the problem which is essential for the research. The authors need to improve the validity and verification of the findings. It is important for the authors to compare (at least at the preliminary level) the findings with the previous studies. Generalization of the findings is crucial when it is a case study.
