- I would like to recommend the author to correct the overall grammatical mistakes throughout the manuscript.
- In keywords, use the words which are not used in the title of the study.
- Authors should decrease the length of first paragraph of the introduction and be specific with the topic.
- Authors should explain why the number of participants are so less, second concern is that majority of the study
  participants were nurses, which may create biasness in interpretation of results.
- There should be separate section of statistical analysis under materials and methods part.
- The results portion is described well, however, as mentioned earlier correct the overall grammatical mistakes.
- The discussion is poor and need more elaboration of the results with some latest related references.
