More objectives could be added to make the analysis robust. The sample companies used in the study are all large cap, which has strong CAGR. It does not make sense to study their financial distress. Mid-cap and small-cap companies could be part of the sample.

In the analysis, it is also observed that during the COVID-19 pandemic, the companies had high Z-scores, except for a decline in the scores of HUL and Britannia. The study also does not use any statistical tests or compare the findings with other research findings.
