The topic of the article is appropriate to current issues. But there are several lack of information that could be filled in to make this article perfect.

The PCR test was stated to be carried out every three days, but there was no statement whether the test was carried out on all respondents or only for some and how to ensure that all respondents regularly return for the test. The information will be more complete if it also states how many people are infected per test. The graphs displayed did not clearly explain the data and give rise to different perceptions.

Regarding the use of masks, there is no description regarding the mask using duration which may be different for each person and affect the mask's effectiveness. Apart from that, procedures of mask use such as changing masks, how to store them, and behavior when wearing masks have not been explained. These behavior can affect mask contamination and become source of disease transmission.
