

Review of: "The Algorithmic Decalogue: A Comprehensive Examination of the A.I. Ten Commandments"

Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

The idea is interesting: to explore how an AI would reinterpret or re-state the Ten Commandments. However, the article lacks some (fundamental) aspects:

1. Which AI has been used to formulate the Ten Commandments?
2. What prompt has been used? It would be necessary to describe the process that led to the formulation by the AI of the Ten Commandments, how it was influenced by the interaction with the author, etc.
3. Which aspects of the "traditional" (Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism, etc.) religions and of the "non-traditional" ones (Scientology, anthroposophy, etc.) do the Ten Commandments incorporate, and how?
4. What original characters (if any) do they contain, and what do such characters indicate (e.g., has the AI developed original thinking?)

In general, the article seems to contain just a first sketch of an idea that needs to be further developed to function as a scientific work, and more references should be added and discussed.
