Report on the manuscript "The Changing Trajectory of Covid-19 and How Immunity is Evolving with It", A. Haque and A.B. Pant.

Comments:

The manuscript presents a general view of the evolution of the covid-19 pandemic disease emphasizing on the evolution of the immunity to the virus. The manuscript offers a reasonable general scenario although without any significant novelty with regard to the essential ideas about immunity. Several aspects, however, could be treated with more detail:

a) The immunity is treated in a general 'medical' way, but the social/geographical status of the human populations probably influences the dynamics of the immunity.

b) To what extent the "changing trajectory" of covid-19 differs (with regard to immunity evolution) from that of other pandemic diseases?
