

Review of: "Building a digital republic to reduce health disparities and improve population health in the United States"

The article addresses an important problem of health disparities and introduces the idea of a digital republic to improve the health of the population in the United States. However, bringing up the example of Estonia (whose population is as large as the capitals of some larger countries), I do not see in the work any calculations or even soft forecasts on how the digital republic would affect reduction in health disparities and improving population's health. The article is only a theoretical review of digital solutions with the possibility of influencing this phenomenon in health care. In my opinion, in presented form it does not contribute much to the issues of health sciences.
