 example: "Trust in public institutions has been a key factor in the acceptance of vaccines in the past." Please provide
 some reference to peer reviewed academic literature.
- I would advise against polemical statements even if this is an opinion paper. You should build you argumentation based on evidence instead, such as previous research.
- The paper could also benefit from additional proof reading to correct grammatical errors.
