**Abstract:** Please replace the term "infectious leaves" with an appropriate one, such as "infected leaves. Similarly, try to use field-specific standard words like "precision or accuracy" instead of "exactness".

**Introduction:** Please rewrite the introduction section because it contains so many irrelevant pieces of information, such as how weather slows down traffic. It will be useful to follow the standard flow of information about the background of your work and specific details about your manuscript.

Literature review and methodology section are not strong enough. Please consider avoiding AI for drafting these important sections (if AI tools were previously used).

The manuscript lacks clarity on the topic. It contains a large number of incorrect key terms that reflect less familiarity of the authors with the field of agriculture. Similarly, a significant amount of spelling and grammatical mistakes may need to be considered before submission. Many statements given in the manuscript contradict, such as quadcopters are not suitable to carry weight, while in the next line, authors claim these quadcopters can be used to input fertilisers and pesticides spray. I recommend it should be thoroughly revised before acceptance.
