

Review of: "Individual and Environmental Risk Factors for COVID- 19 Mortality in Elderly"

The aim of this research is to study "Individual and Environmental Risk Factors for COVID- 19 Mortality in Elderly". The research is interesting and helpful for researchers to understand the Environmental Risk Factors in COVID- 19 Mortality in Elderly. However, after careful review, some concerns should be addressed before publication. Minor revision is suggested to further improve its quality. Specific suggestions are provided below.

- 1. The quality of abstract should be improved. The current abstract is too long.
 - 2. Overall, there are too many punctuation errors in the manuscript:
 - 2.1 In introductory part, especially in the first paragraph.
 - 2.2 Add a full stop (i.e cancer, diabetes..) in legend of figure 4.
 - 2.3 Remove the one brackets symbols from (UV index)) the legends of Figures 6.
 - 2.4 Add space between "response[5]" in section 4.1.2 in paragraph 4.
- 2.5 In Weather parameters and COVID-19 mortality: section add space between [9,24] in paragraph 1 and [5,9] in paragraph 3 and add a comma before "However" in paragraph 1.
 - 2.6 Removed the one full stop (.) from the (72.2 to 43.9 µg/m3..) in section 3.2.
 - 3. It is suggested that the authors re-review the meaning of (positivy and wether) in section 3.1.
- 4. The author has not correctly defined ozone concentration (72.2 to 43.9 $\mu g/m3$) in section 3.2 according to the values in Figure 3.

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
