

Review of: "Research question: What effect does vegetation have on sound pollution in Delhi?"

The view of the study is interesting. However, the Methodology, Results and analysis, and Conclusion section of the paper is not sufficiently rigorous.

The literature cited in the Background section of the paper is representative, but it is all early relevant research and should be updated with relevant literature from recent years. In addition, the Background section should highlight the research questions of the paper.

The Methodology section of the paper should include details of what the 'Arduino science journal' is and details of the tests, such as altitude, distance, climatic conditions, etc.

The Aims and Objectives section stated that the sound frequency at the ITO traffic signal should be recorded and analyzed, but in the Results section, there is only a brief description of the frequency levels with no analysis of the frequency characteristics, which should be added. It should also be noted that the Results section should be supplemented with graphical presentations.

The Conclusion section does not lead to new findings, which restricts the novelty of the paper.
