Please check point 2.1.5, Determination of antioxidant activity:

- The ABTS assay is present in the results but not in the materials and methods.
- Inhibition of albumin denaturation (step 2.1.5.2) is an anti-inflammatory assay and not an antioxidant assay. Please correct.

How many samples have you processed? How many samples were analyzed for the screening? It does not show how many replicates have been made.
