A very rare, syndromic genetic deafness characterized by mild to moderate conductive hearing loss, dysmorphic pinnae and lip pits or dimples. The pinnae are usually small, cupshaped, with helix folded forward, and hearing loss is associated with malformed ossicles and displacement of the external auditory canal.
